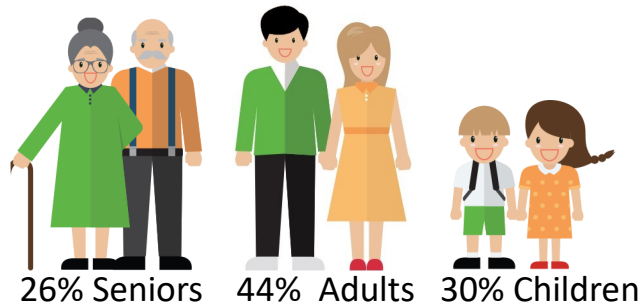

6% purchased



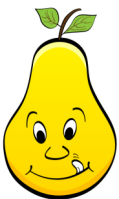
